RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF
 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF
 OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, NEW YORK TO
 THE EXTENT OF \$13,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE
 OF PAYING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A SANITARY
 SEWER ON WASHINGTON AVENUE NEAR FARLEY DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued a Bond Anticipation note or notes in the amount of \$23,620.00 on the 5th day of January 1978 to mature January 5, 1979 for the purpose of paying for the replacement of a Sanitary Sewer on Washington Avenue near Farley Drive, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said note was paid on January 5, 1979, to wit the sum of \$5,620.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$18,000.00 on January 5, 1979 to mature on January 5, 1980, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$18,000.00 will be paid on January 5, 1980, to wit, the sum of \$5,000.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$13,000.00 on January 5, 1980 to mature January 5, 1981, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$13,000.00 by the City of Rensselaer in anticipation of the issuance and sale of Serial Bonds of the City of Rensselaer, authorized by resolution dated November 16, 1977, adopted by the Common Council. Said note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the Bond Anticipation Note hereinbefore described. Neither was the note hereinbefore issued nor is this note issued in anticipation of the sale of bonds for an assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note herein authorized shall be dated January 5, 1980 and mature January 5, 1981.

SECTION 3. The note herein authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer and shall be attested by the City Clerk and sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par and accrued interest at a rate in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said Bond Anticipation note or notes shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the bonds were issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated January 2, 1980 and shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF
 A BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF THE
 CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000.00
 IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$4,000.00
 SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER FOR THE
 PURPOSE OF PAYING A PORTION OF THE COST OF STORM
 SEWER SEPARATION IN THE CITY OF RENSSELAER.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued a Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$12,465.80 on the 6th day of January 1978 to mature on the 6th day of January 1979 for the purposes of paying a portion of the cost of storm sewer separation in the City, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$12,465.80 was paid on January 6, 1979, to wit, the sum of \$4,465.80 and a new note issued in the amount of \$8,000.00 on January 6, 1979 to mature January 6, 1980, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$8,000.00 will be paid on January 6, 1980, to wit, the sum of \$4,000.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$4,000.00 on January 6, 1980 to mature January 6, 1981, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) by the City of Rensselaer in anticipation of the issuance of Serial Bonds of the City of Rensselaer authorized by the Common Council by resolution dated November 16, 1977. Said note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the Bond Anticipation Note hereinbefore described. Neither was the note heretofore issued nor is this note issued in anticipation of the sale of bonds for as assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note herein authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer and shall be attested by the City Clerk and sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 3. The note herein authorized shall be dated January 6, 1980 and mature January 6, 1981.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par and accrued interest at a rate in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York at such time as the Treasurer shall determine in accordance with Section 60:00 of the Local Finance Law. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said bond Anticipation note shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the note was issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated January 2, 1980 and shall take effect immediately.

RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Water or any person designated by him be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute, promulgate and carry out the following rules with respect to rules for the taking of water from fire hydrants in the City of Rensselaer, effective JANUARY 2 1980

No person, individual, firm, corporation or other entity other than the Fire Department, Water Department and Public Works Department of the City of Rensselaer shall be authorized to take any water from any hydrant in the City of Rensselaer without the express written consent of the Commissioner of Water.

In the event that any person, individual, firm, corporation or other legal entity other than those enumerated above, shall make written application to use any hydrant for the purpose of taking water, the Commissioner of Water may grant such permission under the following rules and conditions.

1. The Commissioner shall require that each such user shall make a deposit in cash or certified check payable to the City of Rensselaer, Water Department in the sum not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each day the applicant wishes to take water from any hydrant.

2. The Commissioner of Water shall require that every applicant shall provide a meter to measure the amount of water taken and the applicant shall pay for the water consumed at the rate established for residential consumers in the City of Rensselaer, but in no event shall said charge be less than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each and every day that water shall be taken from the hydrant.

3. The Commissioner of Water may, in his discretion, require that an employee of the Water Department be at the hydrant site where water is being consumed and the applicant shall be required to pay all costs of salary and fringe benefits for said employee during the actual time said employee is, in the sole discretion of the Commissioner, required to be at the site of the hydrant being used.

4. In the event that any damage is caused to the hydrant being used, whether by negligence, accident or otherwise, the applicant shall be obligated to pay all costs involved in the repair of said hydrant.
