WHEREAS the Proposed Budget of the State of New York for 1980/81 provides that certain appropriations of Youth and Recreation Programs be used for "prior obligations" payoff and

WHEREAS the Proposed Budget of the State of New York further provides for across the board reductions in all local assistance programs and

WHEREAS said budget proposals may result in cutbacks of up to 50% and

WHEREAS said cutbacks will result in the New York State Division for Youth reducing reimbursement to municipalities for recreation, youth services, youth bureau administration programs which provide counselling, teen centers, remedial education, day camp, youth employment and other services and

WHEREAS said cutbacks may result in reducing programs offered by the Rensselaer Boy's Club and the Rensselaer Girl's Club

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that upon recommendation of the Rensselaer Youth Bureau, Youth Board and the Youth Committee of the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, the Common Council, the legislative body of the City of Rensselaer, urges the Governor, the Senate of the State of New York and the Assembly of the State of New York to restore to the Division for Youth those budget cuts which will reduce the programs available to the youth of the City of Rensselaer and State of New York and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Hon. Hugh Carey, Governor of the State of New York, Hon. Warren Anderson, Majority Leader of the New York State Senate and the Hon. Stanley Fink, Speaker of the New York State Assembly, *Hon. Richard Connors, Hon. Joseph Buono and The Hon. Neil Kelleher.*
