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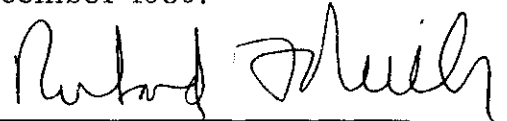

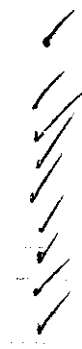
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said fees

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CERTAIN PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

The City of Rensselaer. in Common Council convened, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. On and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or other vehicle on the side or sides herein designated on the following streets in the City of Rensselaer:

1. JOHN STREET. No parking on the south side of John Street between Third Streets and Fourth Street on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. and no parking on the North Side of John Street between Third Street and Fourth Street on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, corporation, association or organization, whether as principal or agent, violating or assisting in the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a traffic infraction and upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and in default of the payment of such fine shall be imprisoned for a period not exceeding Five (5) days.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon completion of publication thereof, pursuant to Section 83 of the Rensselaer City Charter.

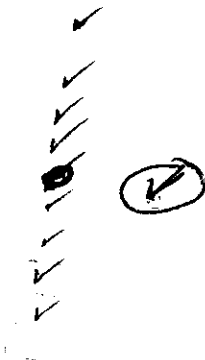

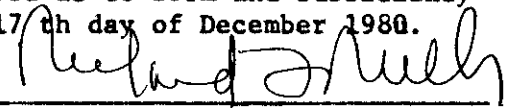

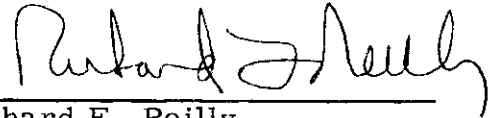
