RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF
A BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF
THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$4,000.00 IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE
OF \$4,000.00 SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY OF
RENSSELAER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR
ENGINEERING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH
CONTRACT #2-SEWER IMPROVEMENTS WEST OF
BROADWAY-PARTITION STREET AREA.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$7,527.54 on the 11th day of June 1980 to mature on the 11th day of June 1981 for the purpose of paying for engineering services in connection with Contract #2-Sewer Improvements West of Broadway-Partition Street Area, and,

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$7,527.54 will be paid on June 11, 1981, to wit, the sum of \$3,527.54 and a new note issued in the amount of \$4,000.00 on June 11, 1981 to mature on June 11, 1982, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$4,000.00 by the City of Rensselaer in anticipation of the issuance of Serial Bonds of the City of Rensselaer authorized by the Common Council by resolution dated May 7, 1980. SAid note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the Bond Anticipation note hereinbefore described. Neither was the note heretofore issued nor is this note issued in anticipation of the sale of an assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer and shall be attested by the City Clerk and sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 3. The note herein authorized shall be dated June 11, 1981 and mature June 11, 1982.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par and accrued interest at a rate in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York at such time as the Treasurer shall determine in accordance with the Local Finance Law. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said Bond Anticipation note shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the note was issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated June 3, 1981 and shall take effect immediately.


