RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF
A BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF
THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$6,000.00 IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE
OF \$6,000.00 SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY OF
RENSSELAER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR
THE COST OF LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE
PAVING OF FIRST STREET, WOODLAND AVENUE,
FARLEY DRIVE, FIFTH STREET AND THIRD
AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$26,000.00 on the 22nd day of November 1978 to mature November 22, 1979 for the purpose of paying the cost of labor and materials for the paving of First Street, Woodland Ave, Farley Drive, Fifth Street and Third Avenue, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$26,000.00 was paid on November 22, 1979, to wit, the sum of \$6,000.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$20,000.00 on November 22, 1979 to mature November 22, 1980, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$20,000.00 was paid on November 22, 1980, to wit, the sum of \$8,000.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$12,000.00 on November 22, 1980 to mature November 22, 1981, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$12,000.00 note will be paid on November 22, 1981 and a new note issued in the sum of \$6,000.00 on November 22, 1981 to mature on November 22, 1982, NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$6,000.00 by the City of Rensselaer in anticipation of the issuance of Serial Bonds of the City of Rensselaer authorized by the Common Council by Resolution dated November 15, 1978. Said note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the bond anticipation note hereinbefore described. Neither was the note heretofore issued nor is this note issued in anticipation of the sale of bonds for an assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer and shall be attested by the City Clerk and sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 3. The note authorized shall be dated November 22, 1981 and mature November 22, 1982.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par and accrued interest at a rate in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York at such time as the Treasurer shall determine in accordance with Section 60:00 of the Local Finance Law. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said bond Anticipation note shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the note was issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated November 18, 1981 and shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000 00 IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$4,000.00 SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING A PORTION OF THE COST OF ADDITION TO G. S. MINK AND T. CLAXTON FIRE HOUSE

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued one Bond Anticipation note in the amount of \$19,875.00 on the 22nd day of November 1978 to mature November 22 1979 for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of and addition to G.S. Mink and T. Claxton Fire House, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$19,875.00 was paid on November 22, 1979, to wit, the sum of \$5,875.00 and a new note issued in the amount of \$14,000.00 on November 22, 1979 to mature November 22, 1980, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$14,000.00 note was paid on November 22, 1980, to wit, the sum of \$6,000.00 and a new note issued in the sum of \$8,000.00 on November 22, 1980 to mature November 22, 1981, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said \$8,000.00 will be paid on November 22, 1981, to wit, the sum of \$4,000.00 and a new note issued in the sum of \$4,000.00 on November 22, 1981 to mature November 22, 1982, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTROL OF PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF WISCONSIN AVENUE IN THE CITY OF RENSSELAER FROM THE POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON AVENUE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF WISCONSIN AVENUE TO THE RENSSELAER CITY LINE

THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN COMMON COUNCIL CONVENED DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ON AND AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE, WISCONSIN AVENUE ON THE EAST SIDE THEREOF COMMENCING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON AVENUE AND SOUTHERLY THEREFROM ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF SAID WISCONSIN AVENUE TO THE RENSSELAER CITY LINE IS DESIGNATED A FIRE LANE AND IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL AT ANY TIME TO PARK ANY VEHICLE ON OR ALONG SAID PORTION OF SAID STREET.

Section 2. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PUBLICATION FOR TWO SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER.
