
ORINANCE NO. 1 FOR 1985

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE
SOUTHERLY SIDE OF THIRD AVENUE
AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH
HIGH STREET


The City of Rensselaer, in Common Council convened,
does hereby ordain and enact:

1. There is hereby established a zone prohibiting the parking of motor vehicles commencing on the southerly side of Third Avenue at a point which is the intersection of the extension of the boundary line between Nos. ~~148~~ 148 and 150 Third Avenue, and thence along Third Avenue in a generally easterly direction and High Street in a generally southerly direction for a distance of 113 feet from said point of intersection.
2. The zone shall be adequately marked by the posting of signs thereupon and therein.
3. Any person, individual or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00 for each violation.
4. This ordinance shall take effect on January 15, 1985.

WHEREAS, the Rensselaer Planning and Development Agency has responsibility for implementing said grant, as well as for performing certain city planning functions such as land use and environmental review and transportation coordination, and

WHEREAS, the position of Planning and Development Assistant has been established in the budget to assist the Director of said agency in performing the various duties of this office

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer hereby authorizes the Mayor to fill by appointment the position of Planning and Development Assistant and further authorizes that said position carry an annual salary of \$16,500, plus applicable fringe benefits, which salary shall be partially funded through the FY 84 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant in the proportion previously established.
