AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF RENSSELAER
TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COST
OF CONSTRUCTION OF A FEDERAL-AID
PROJECT NOT ON THE STATE
HIGHWAY SYSTEM ADMINISTERED BY
THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, a Project for the improvement of East Street and Partition Street in the City of Rensselaer, PIN 1751.64, funded under a Federal-Aid Program, provided for in Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, calls for the apportionment of costs for the project to be borne at the ratio of 75% Federal funds and 25% State or local funds for that portion funded with 10% federal-aid urban system funds and 90% Federal funds and 10% State or local funds for that portion funded with federal-aid hazard elimination program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Rensselaer Common Council, desires to advance the project by making a commitment for 22% of the non-Federal share of the cost of construction of the project, including construction engineering (inspection) costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Rensselaer Common Council, duly convened does hereby

RESOLVE, that the Council, approves of the above subject project; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the participation of the City of Rensselaer in the cost of the construction of the project including construction engineering (inspection costs) by execution of a Certified Check to the order of the State Comptroller prior to award of the contract; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Authorization shall commit the City to an amount not to exceed \$16,500.00 for the entire cost of this project; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sum of \$16,500.00 is hereby appropriated to cover the cost of its participation in the above phase of the project, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to deposit such sum with the State Comptroller prior to award of the contract; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be filed with the State Commissioner of Transportation, it being understood that upon completion of the above project, the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New York

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING, DIRECTING AND ESTABLISHING A NEW SCHEDULE OF RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF WATER THROUGHOUT THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AND PART OF THE TOWN OF NORTH GREENBUSH.

The City of Rensselaer, in Common Council convened, does ordain as follows:

1. WATER RATE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1986:

It is hereby ordered, directed and established that effective January 1, 1986, the rate charged for the consumption of water furnished by the City of Rensselaer Water System through purchase from the City of Troy to consumers in the City of Rensselaer and part of the Town of North Greenbush shall be \$2.43 per 1000 gallons.

2. MINIMUM MONTHLY AND SEMI-ANNUAL CHARGES:

It is hereby further ordered, directed and established that effective January 1, 1986, the minimum monthly charge for such service shall be established at \$17.00 and minimum semi-annual charge for such service shall be established at \$45.20, semi-annual fire service charge will be \$180.00.

All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof, inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1986.
