RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A BUDGET NOTE OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR CLAIMS FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE BILLS FOR JOINT WATER FACILITIES WITH THE TOWN OF EAST GREENBUSH.

Whereas, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued a Budget Note in the amount of \$37,000.00 on the 2nd day of May 1986 to mature on the 2nd day of May 1987 for the purpose of paying for claims for Operation and Maintenance Bills for Joint Water Facilities with the Town of East Greenbush, and

Whereas, said note mature May 2, 1987 and the Common Council desires to provide for the renewal of said note in the amount of \$20,000.00 and said note to be date May 2, 1987 and mature May 2, 1988, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Budget Note in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars by the City of Rensselaer for the purpose of renewing the said Budget Note hereinbefore described. The date of maturity of such note to be issued and said note shall not and does not exceed beyond the applicable period provided in Section 29:01 of the Local Finance Law, to wit, upon the closing of the fiscal year succeeding the fiscal year in which note was issued. Said note shall be dated May 2, 1987 and mature May 2, 1988.

SECTION 2. That, except as herein specifically prescribed, said note shall be of the date, terms, form, contents and place of payment at a rate of interest that may be determined by the City Treasurer, consistent however, with the provisions of the Local Finance Law. The note shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer and attested by the City Clerk and Sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 3. Said note shall be sold at private sale by the City Treasurer at a price of not less than par value and accrued interest, if any, and upon the execution of said note the same shall be delivered to the purchaser upon the payment by him to the City Treasurer of the Purchase price in cash. The receipt of the City Treasurer shall be a full acquittance of such purchaser who shall not be obliged to see the application of the Purchase money.

SECTION 4. The full faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note.

SECTION 5. The proceeds of such Budget note need not be deposited in a special account but may be commingled with other funds of the issuer in a bank or Trust Company authorized to business in this State.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated April 15, 1987 and shall take effect immediately.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE IN THE VICINITY OF 544 BROADWAY.


The City of Rensselaer in Common Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:

1. There is hereby established a zone prohibiting the parking of motor vehicles on the east side of Broadway for a distance of 62 feet northerly along said Broadway from the street light pole in front of No. 544 Broadway from 3:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. Monday through Saturday.
2. The zone shall be adequately marked by the posting of signs therein and thereupon.
3. Any person, individual or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to fine of not less than \$5.00 for each violation.



WHEREAS the City has no present or contemplated use for its fire lanes in the vicinity of said fire house.


