LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 1970
A Local Law of the City of Rensselaer in Relation to Open Containers & Bottles
BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS

No person shall have in his possession any open bottle or container containing Liquor, beer, wine or other alcoholic beverage, which such person is on any public highway, public street, public sidewalk, public parking area, public playground or in any conveyance, vehicle, ~~boat~~, or public place excepting those premises duly licensed for sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises.

Any open bottle or open container in or on any conveyance or vehicle, shall be presumptive evidence that the same is in possession of all occupants thereof, in violation hereof.

A violation of this law shall constitute a violation punishable by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars or by imprisonment in the Rensselaer County Jail for ten days or by both such fine and imprisonment for the first offence, and by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the Rensselaer County Jail for thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment for the second and subsequent offenses.

Should any section or provision of this ordinance be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional.

This local law shall take effect after publication pursuant to the provisions of the City Charter.

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A \$50,000.00 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, NEW YORK TO THE EXTENT OF \$50,000.00 IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING A PORTION OF THE COST OF MATERIALS AND SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW WATER SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF RENSSELAER.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer, New York has heretofore authorized and issued a Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of materials and services in connection with the joint construction of a new water system for the City of Rensselaer to mature July 31, 1970 and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York desires to provide for the renewal of said bond anticipation note issued July 31, 1969 to mature July 31, 1970, Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$50,000.00 by the City of Rensselaer, New York authorized by resolution dated July 16, 1969, adopted by the Common Council, and said note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the bond anticipation note hereinbefore described. Neither was this note or the note hereinbefore described issued in anticipation of the sale of bonds for an assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note herein authorized shall be dated July 31, 1970 and mature July 31, 1971.

SECTION 3. The note hereby authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and Treasurer, shall be attested by the City Clerk and shall be sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par and accrued interest as the Treasurer shall determine in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said Bond Anticipation note shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the notes were issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated July 15, 1970 and shall take effect immediately.

**CAPITAL NOTE RESOLUTION OF JULY 15, 1970
AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AND SALE OF CAPITAL
NOTE OR NOTES OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$2900.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING
FOR REPAIRS TO THE HEATING SYSTEM AT RING FIRE
HOUSE.**

**BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York
as follows:**

SECTION 1. There shall be borrowed on the credit of the City of Rensselaer, New York the sum of \$2900.00 for the purpose of providing funds to pay for repairs to the Heating System at Ring Fire House - - - - - heretofore authorized by this Common Council a Capital Note or Notes shall be issued in the amount of \$2900.00 pursuant to the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 2. The maximum cost of the purchase and aquisition of such equipment for which the said Capital Note or Notes shall be issued is the sum of \$2900.00 The plan for financing such costs consist of the issuance and sale of a capital note or notes in the amount of \$2900.00 and the balance of the cost, to wit, is to be paid from current revenues and charged to budgetary code A 290-650.

SECTION 3. It is hereby determined that the purpose for which said note or notes is to be issued, to wit, for repairs to the Heating System at Ring Fire House - - - falls within Section 11:00 Subdivision 32 of the Local Finance Law and the period of probable usefulness of such purpose is Five years.

SECTION 4. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to sell said note or notes at such time as he shall determine at either public and/or private sale. The City Treasurer is further authorized to determine consistently with the Local Finance Law and the terms of this Resolution, the date, maturity, denominations, for and all other matters in connection with said note or notes not herein specifically determined.

SECTION 5. Said note or notes shall be executed in the name of the City by the Mayor and City Treasurer and shall bear the Corporate seal of the City.

SECTION 6. The full faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer shall be and are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said note or notes and an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said note or notes shall be included in the annual budget and levied as a part of the taxes for the fiscal year in which each note matures.

SECTION 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
