RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF \$16,324.00 CAPITAL NOTE OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, NEW YORK TO THE EXTENT OF \$10,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING A PORTION OF THE COST OF TWO 1971 DODGE DUMP TRUCKS FOR USE IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized the issuance of a Capital Note in the amount of \$16,324.00 for the purchase of two (2) 1971 Dodge dump trucks per resolution Number 11, dated January 20, 1971 and,

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer, New York, has heretofore issued a Capital Note in the amount of \$16,324.00 to mature August 16, 1971 and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the principal of the \$16,324.00 Capital Note has been redeemed, namely Six Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$6,324.00) from a source other than the proceeds of the notes, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer desires to provide for the issuance of a Capital Note in the amount of \$10,000.00 and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be borrowed on the credit of the City of Rensselaer, New York the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of providing funds to pay a portion of the cost of two 1971 Dodge Dump Trucks for use in the Public Works Department heretofore contracted for and purchased by this Council, a capital note or notes in the amount of \$10,000.00 pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 2. The maximum cost of the purchase of said equipment, two 1971 Dodge Dump Trucks, for which the Capital Notes were issued was \$16,324.00

SECTION 3. It is hereby determined that the purpose for which said note or notes is to be issued, to wit; the paying a portion of the cost of two(2) 1971 Dodge Dump Trucks for use in the Public Works Department falls within Section 11.00 Subdivision 32-A of the Local Finance Law and the probable usefulness of such purpose is five years.

SECTION 4. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to sell said note or notes at such time or times as he shall determine at either public or private sale. The City Treasurer is further authorized to determine consistently with the Local Finance Law and the terms of this resolution, the date, maturity, denominations, form and all other matters in connection with said note or notes not herein specifically determined.

SECTION 5. Said note shall be executed in the name of the City by the Mayor and the City Treasurer and shall bear the corporate seal of the City.

SECTION 6. The full faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer shall be and are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said note or notes and an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said note or notes and a part of the taxes for the fiscal year in which each note matures.

SECTION 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
