WHEREAS it is deemed in the best interest of the Residents of the City of Rensselaer to replace said vehicle at the earliest possible date and that the replacement of said vehicle cannot await the requirements of competitive bidding

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Safety be and they hereby are authorized and directed to negotiate the purchase of a replacement unit suitable for use in the Police Department and that the Mayor be authorized and directed to enter into a contract and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Treasurer be and he hereby is authorized and directed to finance said purchase by means available pursuant to Statute pending recovery of insurance proceeds or recovery after litigation.
