AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING, DIRECTING AND ESTABLISHING A NEW SCHEDULE OF RATES TO BE CHARGES FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF WATER THROUGHOUT THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE CITY OF RENSSELAER IN THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AND PART OF THE TOWN OF NORTH GREENBUSH

The City of Rensselaer in Common Council convened, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. It is hereby ordered, directed and established that effective August 1, 1975, the following Schedule of Rates charged for the consumption of water furnished by the City of Rensselaer Water System through purchase from the City of Troy to consumers in the City of Rensselaer and part of the Town of North Greenbush shall be in force
