RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE OR NOTES OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, NEW YORK TO THE EXTENT OF \$6,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COST OF ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN, GENERAL SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS ON THIRD AVENUE FROM HIGH STREET TO CITY LINE AND IMPROVEMENTS TO DRAINAGE ON SEVENTH STREET.

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer has heretofore authorized and issued a Bond Anticipation Note or Notes in the amount of \$24,553.52 on the 27th day of September 1974 for the purpose of paying the cost of Engineering Services for the design, General Supervision and inspection for Street and Sewer Improvements on Third Avenue from High Street to City Line and Improvements to Drainage on Seventh Street, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said note was paid on September 27, 1975, to wit, the sum of \$8,553.52, and a new note issued in the sum of \$16,000.00 on September 27, 1975 to mature September 27, 1976, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said note was paid on September 27, 1976, to wit, the sum of \$6,000.00 and a new note issued on September 27, 1976 in the amount of \$10,000.00 to mature on September 27, 1977, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said note will be paid September 27, 1977, to wit, the sum of \$4,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council desires to provide for the renewal of said Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$6,000.00 to be dated September 27, 1977 and mature September 27, 1978, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENSSELAER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be issued one Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$6,000.00 by the City of Rensselaer, New York in anticipation of the issuance and sale of Serial Bonds of the City of Rensselaer, authorized by resolution dated September 18, 1974, adopted by the Common Council. Said note shall be issued for the purpose of renewing the Bond Anticipation Note hereinbefore described. Neither was the note issued nor is this note issued for an assessable improvement.

SECTION 2. The note herein authorized shall be dated September 27, 1977 and mature September 27, 1978.

SECTION 3. The note herein authorized shall be issued in the name of the City by the Mayor and City Treasurer and shall be attested by the City Clerk and shall be sealed with the seal of the City.

SECTION 4. The Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of said note at private sale for not less than par an accrued interest at a rate in accordance with the Local Finance Law of the State of New York. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to determine all matters in relation to said note not specifically determined by said resolution.

SECTION 5. The faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said note. Said Bond Anticipation note or notes shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds in anticipation of which the bonds were issued or may be redeemed as provided by the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall be dated September 21, 1977 and shall take effect immediately.
