Dear Mr. Dwyer:

Penn Central has recently sent a draft of \$ 109,620.31 to the City of Rensselaer in offer of compromise of back taxes. This draft includes money for both City and County taxes. Penn Central was compelled to send these compromise offers to the "collectors" on the original tax levy. The City Treasurer was the person responsible for collection of these taxes, and therefore one draft was submitted for both taxes.

Penn Central acknowledges the fact that the City is no longer responsible for the County taxes. We therefore, have analyzed the payment to determine the City and County's share of the offer. The money due the City is \$ 77,765.24; the County's share is \$ 31,855.07. We advise your office to get in touch with the County Treasurer to work out an agreement to divide the draft.
