WHEREAS, The City of Rensselaer did heretofore and on the 2nd day of September, 1958 enter into a contract with the Callanan Road Improvement Company for the resurfacing of Columbia Street, and

WHEREAS, Said specifications, bid and contract did not provide for a foundation, it being the belief that a foundation existed under Columbia Street, and

WHEREAS, Excavation in the course of performance of the contract disclosed no such foundation at a time when the main artery of the City was torn up, and

WHEREAS, A foundation is and was necessary for a workmanlike performance of the contract, and required 920 cubic yards of concrete and 865 cu. yards of crushed stone in place, be it hereby,

RESOLVED, That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to enter into a supplemental contract, after approval thereof by the Corporation Counsel, with the Callanan Road Improvement Company for 920 cubic yards of concrete and 865 cubic yards of crushed stone in place at a fair and reasonable price.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE FOR THE COLLECTION OF WATER RENTS AND PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE BILLING AND COLLECTION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

THE CITY OF RENSSELAER, IN COMMON COUNCIL, CONVENEED, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Effective April 1, 1959, the following schedule is hereby established for the collection of water rents through the City Treasurer's office in behalf of the Water Dept.

1. Industrial consumers shall continue to be billed monthly.
2. On Routes 1 thru 4 in the City of Rensselaer, the meters shall be read and the consumers billed in the months of February and August in each year, and the water rents therefor shall be payable in March and September of each year.
3. On Routes 5 thru 7 in the City of Rensselaer, the meters shall be read and the consumers billed in the months of September and March in each year, and the water rents therefor shall be payable in April and October of each year.
4. On Routes 8 thru 10 in the City of Rensselaer, the meters shall be read and the consumer billed in the months of April and October in each year and the water rents therefor shall be payable in May and November of each year.
5. On Routes 11 thru 14 in the City of Rensselaer, the meters shall be read and consumers billed in the months of November and May in each year and the water rents therefor shall be payable in December and June of each year.
6. East Greenbush is to be read in June and December, payable in July and January.

SECTION 2. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps he may deem necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
