In accordance with section eleven of article nine of the Constitution, a message was received from the city of Rensselaer and read in words following:

To the Legislature:

Pursuant to section eleven of article nine of the Constitution, as Mayor of the city of Rensselaer

and with the concurrence of the Common Council

being the local legislative body of such city, I, CLARENCE A. McNALLY

hereby request the enactment of legislation as set forth in

~~Senate~~ bill (Printed No. 2042, Int. No. 2036) entitled "Assembly (strike out one)

"An act to repeal sections one hundred seventy-five, one hundred seventy-six and one hundred seventy-seven of chapter sixty-nine of the laws of nineteen hundred fifteen, entitled, "Rensselaer City Charter," relating to fees and proceedings of the city treasurer in the collection of county taxes in Rensselaer"

I hereby declare that a necessity exists for the enactment of such legislation for the following reasons:

1. (Strike out A or B)

A. That the city has not the power to enact such legislation by local law.

B. That the city has not the power to enact such legislation by local law without a referendum, which, for the reasons set forth below, is deemed undesirable.
