BY ALDERMAN Praft and Buono:

WHEREAS, the City of Rensselaer is presently furnishing water to the inhabitants of certain portions of the Town of East Greenbush pursuant to order of the Water Resources Commission of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, in the past week, due to an accident involving pumping facilities a state of public emergency exists in the Town of East Greenbush by reason of lack of sufficient water in the storage tank used to supply portions of said Town, and

WHEREAS, to correct such condition and to insure the availability of more water to such inhabitants of the Town of East Greenbush, requires immediate action which cannot await competitive bidding, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that a state of public emergency does exist in portions of the Town of East Greenbush by reason of the foregoing circumstances, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Water be and he hereby is authorized, directed and empowered to immediately purchase the material or equipment and to contract for the labor and services, including engineering services, necessary to eliminate the said condition, after approval thereof by the Corporation Counsel, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Water submit a report in full to this Council upon completion of the foregoing public work or at the next regular meeting of the Council to be held on July 5th, 1961, listing the nature, extent and cost of all such materials, equipment and labor and services purchased by him in connection with the said public work;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the cost thereof be defrayed by the issuance of Serial Bonds of the City pursuant to the Local Finance Law and that such costs are hereby determined to be a part of and shall be included in the capital improvements in connection with the City's development of a new water supply.
