- RESOLUTION -

ALDERMAN

offered the following:

WHEREAS there has been presented to the Common Council at its regular meeting held July 18, 1962, a petition of the Albany Port District Commission requesting the consent of the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer for the contracting of an indebtedness in the sum of Three Hundred Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$308,982.50) the proportionate amount of which indebtedness which would be allocated to the City of Rensselaer being the sum of Twenty-one Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars and Seventy-seven Cents (\$21,628.77), computed according to the provisions of Section 120 of the Local Finance Law, to be evidenced by tax and revenue anticipation notes of the said District Corporation, and to be repaid from the proceeds of taxes heretofore caused by the said Albany Port District to be levied and collected by the Cities of Albany and Rensselaer for the 1962-1963 fiscal year of the District Corporation, and from revenues obtained from the use of the facilities of the Commission for said period, and

WHEREAS, there has been presented at the same time the certificate of John J. Dwyer, Treasurer and Chief Fiscal Officer of the City of Rensselaer, setting forth the information required by Article 2, Title 8 of the Local Finance Law, and

WHEREAS a notice that a public hearing would be held at the Common Council Chambers on the 1st day of August, 1962, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., DST., was published in the Knickerbocker News, an official newspaper and a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Rensselaer, on the 20th day of July, 1962, and

WHEREAS no one has appeared in opposition thereto;

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Rensselaer hereby gives its consent to the contracting of an indebtedness by the Albany Port District Commission in the sum of Three Hundred Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$308,982.50) the proportionate amount of which indebtedness which would be allocated to the City of Rensselaer being the sum of Twenty-one Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars and Seventy-seven Cents (\$21,628.77), computed according to the provisions of Section 120 of the Local Finance Law, to be evidenced by tax and revenue anticipation notes of the said District Corporation, and to be repaid from the proceeds of taxes heretofore caused by the said Albany Port District Commission to be levied and collected by the Cities of Albany and Rensselaer, for the 1962-1963 fiscal year of the said District Corporation, and from revenues obtained from the use of the facilities of the Commission for said period.
