CAPITAL NOTE RESOLUTION OF OCTOBER 30, 1963 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AND SALE OF CAPITAL NOTE OR NOTES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8100.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CASE LOADER AND BACK-HOE TO BE USED BY THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be borrowed on the credit of the City of Rensselaer, New York the sum of \$8100.00 for the purpose of providing funds to pay for the cost of One Case Loader and Back-Hoe for use in the Public Works Department, heretofore authorized by this Common Council a Capital Note or notes shall be issued in the amount of \$8100.00 pursuant to the Local Finance Law of the State of New York.

SECTION 2. The maximum cost of the purchase and acquisition of such equipment for which the said Capital Note or notes shall be issued is the sum of \$8250.00. The plan for financing such costs consist of the issuance and sale of a capital note or notes in the amount of \$8100.00 and the balance of the cost, to wit, \$150.00 is to be paid from current revenues and charged to budgetary central Code A290-650.

SECTION 3. It is hereby determined that the purpose for which said note or notes is to be issued, to wit, the purchase of one case loader & back-hoe falls within Section 11:00 Subdivision 32 of the Local Finance Law, and the period of probable usefulness of such purpose is five (5) years.

SECTION 4. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to sell said note or notes at such time as he shall determine at either public or private sale. The City Treasurer is further authorized to determine consistently with the Local Finance Law and the terms of this Resolution, the date, maturity, denominations, for and all other matters in connection with said note or notes not herein specifically determined.

SECTION 5. Said note or notes shall be executed in the name of the City by the Mayor and City Treasurer and shall bear the corporate seal of the City.

SECTION 6. The full faith and credit of the City of Rensselaer shall be and are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said note or notes and an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said note or notes shall be included in the annual budget and levied as a part of the taxes for the fiscal year in which each note matures.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
