Any unexpended funds should be used to reduce that loan. This transfer is prohibited by Article Two, Section Six, Subdivision Two of the General Municipal Law.

Rigney, the contractor to whom the aforesaid contract was awarded has partially completed said contract at a total cost of \$35,866.52 of which there is to be retained in accordance with the provisions of said contract price, the sum of \$5,379.98 leaving a balance of \$30,486.54 of which sum he has been paid previously \$23,596.02 leaving a balance due at this time of \$6890.52 of which sum the inspector shall be paid \$122.99 and the contractor the balance of \$6767.53; and

WHEREAS it was duly provided that the expense of completing said contract be defeayed by the issuance and sale of bonds and pending the issuance and sale of bonds, by the issuance and sale of bond sale certificates of indebtedness; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED: That the City Treasurer be and she hereby is authorized and directed to negotitiate at private sale a bond sale certificate of indebtedness in the said sum of \$6890.52 dated the 4th day of January, 1940 or such later date as said City Treasurer may determine; bearing interest at a rate of not to exceed 2½% per annum both principal and interest to be payable 3rd day of July, 1940 and that said certificate shall be issued in registered form and shall be subject to earlier call for payment at the option of the city upon ten (10) days notice in writing to the registerd holder; and be it further

RESOLVED; That said bond sale certificate of indebtedness shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the Rensselaer County Bank and Trust Company, Rensselaer, New York, with New York exchange and shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk, and sealed with the corporate seal of the City, and otherwise shall be in such form and contain such recitals as the officer executing the same shall determine; and be it further

RESOLVED; That the said bond sale certificate of indebtedness shall be sold by the City Treasurer at private sale for not less tha par at the best rate of interest obtainable, not exceeding the rate above specified and the proceeds of the sale thereof shall be applied solely to the p rpose aforesaid and that said certificate of indebtedness shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of bonds to be authorized by the Council for such purpose.
