NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given, that pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York, at a special meeting held on the 12th day of November, 1942, a public hearing will be held in the Council Chambers in the City Hall, Rensselaer, New York, on the 24th day of November, 1942, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., Eastern War Time, of that day, and the purpose of the said hearing is to consider the petition of the Albany Port District Commission in which the said Albany port District Commission requests and prays that the Common Council of the City of Rensselaer, New York, give its consent to the contracting by the said Albany Port District Commission of an indebtedness in the sum of \$91,732.50 of which indebtedness \$5,816.52 would be allocated to the City of Rensselaer. The indebtedness proposed to be contracted is for the purpose of paying interest due on bonds heretofore issued by the said Albany Port District Commission and is to be evidenced by certificates of indebtedness to be repaid from the collection of taxes heretofore levied by the said Albany port District Commission for its fiscal year 1942-43, and collected by the Cities of Albany and Rensselaer.

The certificate of Harvey C. Younghans, City Clerk of the City of Rensselaer, executed pursuant to section 6-A of the General Municipal Law and presented to the Common Council on the 7th day of October, 1942, is as follows:

I, HARVEY C. YOUNGHANS, Clerk of the City of Rensselaer, New York, do hereby certify to the requirements of Section 6-A of the General Municipal Law, as follows:

1. The average assessed valuation of the real property within the City of Rensselaer subject to the levy of taxes by or on behalf of

the petitioning corporate district, Albany Port District Commission, is \$16,015,900.00, and the most recent valuation of the real property therein subject to the levy of taxes by or on behalf of the petitioning corporate district, Albany Port District Commission, is \$18,199,204.00.

2. The outstanding indebtedness of the City of Rensselaer is \$1,204,338.03 and the percentage which such indebtedness bears to the average assessed valuation of the City of Rensselaer is .0627.

3. The proportionate amount of the indebtedness proposed to be contracted by the Albany Port District Commission which would be allocated to the City of Rensselaer is \$5,816.12, and the percentage which such proportionate amount of the indebtedness, bears to the average assessed valuation of the municipality is .00036, and the percentage which such indebtedness bears to the average assessed valuation of the real property within the City of Rensselaer, subject to the levy of taxes by or on behalf of the petitioning corporate district, Albany Port District Commission is .00036.
