Whereas, the City Clerk did publish said advertisement in the paper and at the times and in the manner as directed by this Common Council, and proposals for the doing of said work have been duly opened, tabulated and considered; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the repaving with reinforced concrete where necessary sections of the roadway of Columbia Street from the east erly City line westerly about 1500 feet in the City of Rensselaer, N. Y. be done in accordance with the maps, plans, profiles and specifications heretofore duly approved and adopted by this Common Council; and be it further

Resolved, that the rproposal of Vicent Di Guilio in the aggregate sum of \$12,625.00, estimate for the making of the improvement above set forth in this City, be and the same is hereby adopted; and the said Cincnt Di Guilio being the lowest responsible bidder for the doing of said work, be it further

Resolved, that the Mayor of this City be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed in the name and on behalf of this City to enter into a contract, duly approved by the Corporation Counsel, with the said Vincent Di Guilio for the doing of said work in accordance with said resolution so adopted and the said maps, plans, profiles and specifications; the contract to be in the form now before this Common Council and to be sealed with the corporate seal of this City; however, that the said Vincent Di Guilio execute and deliver to the City a bond as specified in said specifications.
