A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RED LION, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO ESTABLISH A ROAD SIGN ASSESSMENT AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the U.S Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration has published a Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition, as revised ("2009 WUCTD") which establishes, among other things, minimum standards for maintaining retroreflectivity of road signs; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 MUCTD requires governmental entities to implement and continue the use of assessment or management method that is designed to maintain regulatory and warning signs retroreflectivity at or above minimum levels established by the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of Red Lion, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Resolved by the same, that Red Lion Borough has implemented, and will continue to use, the Assessment Method for future sign replacement and maintaining sign retroreflectivity, with respect to regulatory and warning signs located within the Borough, at or above minimum standards established by the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration and published in the 2009 MUCTD at Table 2A-3. Red Lion Borough shall assess compliance with the Minimum Maintained Retroreflectivity standards set forth in the 2009 MUCTD on an annual basis and provide for adequate funding to comply with sign retroreflectivity replacement.
