

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-09

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 210. OFFENSES, ARTICLE XIV. FIREWORKS, SECTION 210.2210 SALE OF FIREWORKS PROHIBITED - WHEN

WHEREAS, the City of Reeds Spring acknowledges that the Fireworks Ordinance is lacking specific information in regards to the sale of fireworks.

WHEREAS, the term "fireworks" needs to be clearly defined.

WHEREAS, the length of time allowed to sell fireworks should align with the Missouri Department of Public Safety Fireworks Permitting and Licensing.

WHEREAS, age restriction should be stated when purchasing fireworks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF REEDS SPRING MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 210.2210. Sale of Fireworks Prohibited - When

It shall be unlawful for any person within the City to discharge or cause to be discharged, ignited, fired or otherwise set in action within the City limits any fireworks, or explosive or any other substance designed or intended for pyrotechnical use, except as provided in Section 210.2240. These include, but are not limited to, firecrackers, bottle rockets, sparklers, torpedoes, roman candles, fire balloons, squibs, snakes and spit-devils. The manufacture of any fireworks or explosives as defined by the USDT is also prohibited within City limits. It shall be unlawful to sell fireworks within the City limits of the City of Reeds Spring Missouri, on any days of the year except June 20th through July 10th. Fireworks may only be sold to individuals aged seventeen (17) years and older.
