AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 210. OFFENSES, ARTICLE XIV. FIREWORKS, SECTION 210.2220.
DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS - WHEN

WHEREAS, the City of Reeds Spring acknowledges that the Fireworks Ordinance is lacking specific information in regards to the sale of fireworks.

WHEREAS, burning ban restrictions should be stated.

WHEREAS, the dates allowed to discharge fireworks needs to be expanded for consumer convenience.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF REEDS SPRING MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:


Section 210-2220. Discharge of Fireworks - When

Unless a burn ban is in effect by the Southern Stone County Fire Protection District, the discharge of fireworks by the general public is permitted inside the City limits on the following days and time:


1. July 2 through July 6
2. Discharge of fireworks shall be limited to between the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. except for July 4th when the limit shall be extended to 12:00 A.M. (Midnight).


