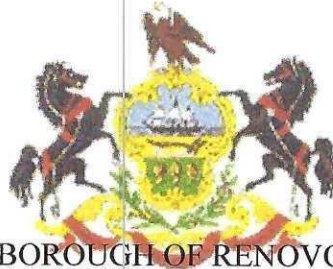

RESOLUTION 15-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RENOVO, CLINTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO APPOINT MEMBERS & ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE ZONING HEARING BOARD

WHEREAS, the Borough of Renovo has enacted a Zoning Ordinance and established a Zoning Hearing Board in accordance with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code ("MPC"); and

WHEREAS, Section 903 of the MPC provides that members and alternate members of the Zoning Hearing Boards are to be appointed by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to appoint members and alternate members of the Zoning Hearing Board.

WHEREAS, Ellen Anderson resigned July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

WHEREAS, Corey Aungst was appointed by Council on September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to fill the remaining term of Ellen Anderson that expires on 12/31/25.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Renovo, Clinton County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 903 (a) of the Pa Municipalities Planning Code, 53 PS 10903 (a), Council appoints the following persons as members of the Zoning Hearing Board of Renovo Borough, Clinton County, Pennsylvania with the terms of office expiring as set forth below:

**Corey Aungst to fill the remaining term of Ellen Anderson beginning 9/12/24 and expiring 12/31/25.**


Section 2. Pursuant to Section 903 (b) of the Pa Municipalities Planning Code, 53 PS 10903 (b), Council appoints the following person as alternate member of the Zoning Hearing Board of Renovo Borough, Clinton County, Pennsylvania with the terms of office expiring as set forth below:

Section 3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution it being the intent of Council that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
