AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIVER VALE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, REPEALING CHAPTER 170 OF THE CODE ENTITLED “PEACE AND GOOD ORDER” SECTION 170-4 “INTERFERENCE WITH FIRE FIGHTING OPERATIONS”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of River Vale that Chapter 170 of the Code entitled “Peace and Good Order” Section 170-4 “Interference with Fire Fighting Operations” is hereby repealed as follows:

Section 170-4 Interference with Fire Fighting Operations

~~No person or persons shall drive any vehicle over any hose or other apparatus nor willfully handle and do violence to any member of the Fire Department or any official of the Township in the performance of his duty at a fire or in going to or returning from a fire or alarm of fire or in charge of any apparatus; nor shall any person or persons raise, create or continue a false alarm of fire.~~

This Ordinance shall take effect following adoption and approval in a time and manner prescribed by law.
