ORDINANCE NO. 2536

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 375, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING ON SPECIFIC STREETS, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RIDGEFIELD”

Section I. Section 375-5 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield, entitled “No parking areas” be and hereby is amended by adding the following no parking areas:

On the easterly side of Walnut Street, from the intersection of the same with the southerly line of Veterans Memorial Park and running southerly for a distance of 102 feet.

Section II. Section 375-7.1 of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield, entitled “No parking or standing; stopping only for school dropoff and pick up areas” be amended as follows:

Subpart D, be deleted and replaced with the following:

D. Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, when public school is in session, all vehicles are prohibited from parking and standing, and shall be permitted to stop only for the purpose of dropping off or picking up a student who attends Ridgefield Memorial High School:

(1) Easterly side of Walnut Street, beginning at a point 102 feet south of the southern terminus of Veterans Memorial Park and continuing south for 165 feet.

Subpart E, be added as follows:

E. Penalties. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of § 375-7.1A through § 375-7.1D shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of \$28.00.

Section III. Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or other provision of the Code of the Borough of Ridgefield inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflicts.

Section IV: If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section V: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication according to law.
