§ 264-9Penalties for offenses.

<u>A.</u>

Editor's Note: Former Subsection A, concerning penalties for a violation, was repealed 6-12-2013 by L.L. No. 7-2013. See now Subsection <u>C</u>.

Any person issued a notice of violation pursuant to any provision of this chapter shall be subject to an administrative fee of \$100 for each notice. Such administrative fee shall be charged against the land upon the notice of violation was issued as a municipal lien or such administrative fee shall be added to the tax rolls as an assessment of levied as a special tax against said property or recovered in a civil suit against the person(s) to which the notice of violation was issued.

B.

In addition to the enforcement in a criminal proceeding by fine or imprisonment, this chapter may be enforced by instituting a special proceeding as authorized by Article 4 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules to compel compliance with the provisions of this chapter or to restrain by injunction any violation thereof, or to obtain any other appropriate relief.

<u>C.</u>

Any violation of this chapter by any person, firm or corporation shall constitute a violation and shall be punishable by a fine not less than \$500 and no more than the sum of \$1,000 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed 15 days, or both, for conviction of a first offense. Each subsequent violation will be punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$2,000 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed 15 days, or both. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a separate, additional offense. [Amended 6-12-2013 by L.L. No. 7-2013]
