

**ROBINSON TOWNSHIP
RESOLUTION NO. 12 OF 2017**

**A RESOLUTION OF ROBINSON TOWNSHIP
COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE NO.
R-8657 INTO ROBINSON TOWNSHIP FROM NEVILLE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, Act 141 of 2000 ("the Act"), which amends the Commonwealth's Liquor Code, authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of Restaurant Liquor Licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota limitations provided for in Section 461 of the Liquor Code, if sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the receiving municipality issues a resolution approving the transfer of the license outside the municipality to inside the municipality; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Liquor Code stipulate that prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing is held for the purpose of permitting interested parties to state their concerns regarding the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License into the municipality; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the Act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a restaurant liquor license into the receiving municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Cinemark LLC has requested the approval of the Board of Commissioners of Robinson Township for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License R-8657 to its proposed location within Robinson Township, with the understanding that said transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Robinson Township, through its Board of Commissioners, finds that the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License into Robinson Township by Cinemark LLC will not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the municipality of its residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Robinson Township Board of Commissioners approves, by adoption of this Resolution, the proposed inter-municipal liquor license transfer of Cinemark, LLC to 2100 Settlers Ridge Center Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15205.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the license transfer is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
