RESOLUTION NO. 13 OF 2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ROBINSON TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE NO. R-8024 INTO ROBINSON TOWNSHIP FROM THE BOROUGH OF CORAOPOLIS.

WHEREAS, Act 141 of 2000 (the "Act") which amends the Commonwealth's Liquor Code, authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota of limitations provided for in Section 461 of the Liquor Code, if sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the receiving municipality issues a Resolution approving the transfer of the license outside the municipality to inside the municipality; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Liquor Code stipulate that prior to adoption of a Resolution by the receiving Municipality, at least one (1) hearing is held for the purpose of permitting interested parties to state their concerns regarding the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License into the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, an application for the transfer filed under the Act must contain a copy of the Resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License into the receiving Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, CIAMACCO, INC. has requested the approval of the Board of Commissioners of Robinson Township for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License R-8024 to its proposed location at 5624-B Steubenville Pike, McKees

Rocks, Pennsylvania, 15136 within Robinson Township with the understanding that said transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Robinson Township, through its Board of Commissioners, finds that the transfer of a Restaurant Liquor License into Robinson Township by Ciamacco, Inc. will not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the Municipality or its residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Robinson Township Board of Commissioners approves by adoption of this Resolution the proposed Inter-Municipal Liquor License Transfer of Ciamacco, Inc. from 3069 Cliff Mine Road, Coraopolis, Pennsylvania, 15108 to 5624-B Steubenville Pike, McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania, 15136.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the license transfer is subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
