**RESOLUTION NO. 14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE ROBINSON TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY,  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF  
LIQUOR LICENSE NO. R-17149 INTO ROBINSON TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, Act 141 of 2000 ("the Act") authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota limitations provided for in Section 461 of the Liquor Code if, as in Robinson Township, sales of liquor and malt or brewed beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the applicant to obtain from the receiving municipality a resolution approving the inter-municipal transfer of the liquor license prior to an applicant's submission of an application to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Code stipulates that, prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing be held for the purpose of permitting individuals residing within the municipality to make comments and recommendations regarding applicant's intent to transfer a liquor license into the receiving municipality; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the Act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a liquor license into the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Sushi Bomb, LLC has requested the approval of Robinson Township for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania liquor license no. R-17149, from HMS Host USA LLC t/a Houlihan's, 431 Pittsburgh Mills Circle, Frazer Township, Tarentum, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania 15084-3833 to Sushi Bomb, LLC for restaurant facilities within Robinson Township to be located at or about 6302 Robinson Center Drive, Robinson Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania 15205 with the understanding that the liquor license transfer must be approved at a later date by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Robinson Township has held a properly advertised public hearing pursuant to the notice provisions of Section 102 of the Liquor Code to receive comments on the proposed liquor license transfer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Robinson Township approves, by adoption of this Resolution, the proposed inter-municipal transfer of liquor license no. R-17149 into Robinson Township by Sushi Bomb, LLC and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that transfers, designations and assignments of licenses hereunder are subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.
