

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT OF
ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON**

PUBLIC NOTICE

Please take notice that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Robinson at their meeting to be held on February 3, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. prevailing time, at the offices of the Township of Robinson, 1000 Church Hill Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15205; will take action on an Ordinance entitled as follows:

**TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE No. 1 of 2020**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON, A FIRST- CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE 2020 REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR REAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON AT 3.20 MILLS.

WHEREAS, The 2020 Township operating Budget has been developed; and

WHEREAS, The real estate tax rate for the proposed 2020 Budget is to be 3.20 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Robinson, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania have determined that the proposed real estate tax rate is acceptable and necessary for the efficient fiscal administration of the affairs of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON, and it is **HEREBY ORDAINED and ENACTED** as follows:

1. A tax shall be levied and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the said municipality subject to taxation of the fiscal year 2020, as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes,
the sum 3.20 mills
on each dollar of assessed valuation,
or the sum of 32.00 cents
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

THE SAME BEING SUMMARIZED IN TABULAR FORM AS FOLLOWS:

	Mills on each dollar of assessed valuation	Cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation
Tax rate for general purposes	3.20 mills	32.0 cents

2. For purposes of payment on said tax, and the determination of the discount period and the penalty period, it is hereby ordained that the discount period during which discount tax paid hereunder is the month of April and May. Taxes shall be paid at the face amount June and July. Taxes paid after July 31 shall be delinquent.

3. The proper officials of the TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance.

4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other aspects this ordinance shall be cumulative of the other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Ordinance.

5. If any section or provision or parts thereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision of the part thereof.

6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
