RESOLUTION NO. 4 OF 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROBINSON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, EXTENDING THE DISCOUNT AND FACE VALUE PAYMNET DEADLINES FOR TOWNSHIP REAL ESTATE TAXES DUE TO THE COVID-19 GLOBAL OUTBREAK EMERGENCY DECLARATION.

WHEREAS, Governor Tom Wolf has issued a Proclamation of Disaster of Emergency dated March 6, 2020, stating in part that it is critical to prepare for and respond to suspected or confirmed cases in the Commonwealth and to implement measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Robinson, declared a Disaster Emergency in order to implement emergency management procedures to protect the health h, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Robinson by mitigating strategies to increase the containment of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the current deadline for residents to pay Township Real Estate Taxes at a discount rate is May 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the current deadline for residents to pay Township Real Estate Taxes at the face value is July 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, given the above-mentioned disaster declarations due to the COVID-19 virus pandemic, the Board of Commissioners for the Township finds it is in the best interest, of the health, safety and welfare of its residents to extend the deadlines for payment of real estate taxes at a discount rate and face value for a period of thirty (30) days respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Robinson that:

1. The deadline for Township residents to pay Township Real Estate Taxes at the established discount rate shall be June 30, 2020; and
2. The deadline for Township residents to pay Township Real Estate Taxes at the established face value rate shall be August 31, 2020;
3. The Township Tax Collector is directed to establish any procedures reasonably necessary to effectuate the change of these deadlines.

Section 2. That any Resolution, or part of any Resolution, conflicting with this Resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same effects this Resolution.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Resolution is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, invalidity, or illegality shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Resolution. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Township of Robinson that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included herein.

RESOLVED into law this 6th day of APRIL, 2020.
