ORDINANCE #22-21

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS OR PURPOSES TO BE UNDERTAKEN IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCKAWAY, IN THE COUNTY JERSEY, OF MORRIS, NEW APPROPRIATING \$1,354,201.76 THEREFOR CONSTITUTING PROCEEDS OF A GRANT FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCKAWAY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by The Township of Rockaway, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, and there is hereby appropriated therefor the sum of \$1,354,201.76, from the proceeds of a grant received or expected to be received by the Township from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (with a pass through from the State of New Jersey).

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the several purposes for the financing of which the appropriation is made as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance are as follows: the removal and replacement of a gasoline/fuel island and the acquisition by purchase of new and additional equipment including a rescue boat for use by the Fire Department of the Township and six (6) utility vehicles (with outfitting) and one (1) emergency services unit vehicle for use by the Police Department of the Township, including all equipment, accessories,

appurtenances, site work, studies, plans, work, materials and other expenses necessary therefor or

incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans therefor on file or to be filed

in the office of the Township Clerk and hereby approved.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is

hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency

herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the

amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the

Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Township Clerk and are

available for public inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after publication after final passage

as provided by law.
