ORDINANCE NO. 0-23-03 ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN SECTIONS CHAPTERS OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROCKAWAY, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal and enforce such ordinances, regulations, rules, etc. not contrary to the laws of this State or of the United States as it may deem necessary and proper for the good government, order and protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by this subtitle, or by any law; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with the Mayor, it is the opinion of the Council that it is appropriate to repeal certain sections of Chapter 2 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Rockaway; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Council, Sections 2-36 (Reward Committee) and Section 2-39 (Parks and Recreation Planning Committee) are no longer necessary or required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Rockaway, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The following Sections of Chapter 2 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Rockaway, County of Morris and State of New Jersey shall be and the same hereby are repealed in their entirety.

- a. Section 2-36 (Reward Committee) inclusive of Section 2-36.1 and 2-36.2.
- Section 2-39 (Parks and Recreation Planning Committee) including Sections 2-39.1 and 2-39.2.

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, regulations, or parts of ordinances, resolutions and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. If any section, article, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be judged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, article, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed effective.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and approval in accordance with law.
