A local law establishing an eighteen (18) month moratorium on the

SECTION 1:

There is hereby enacted an eighteen (18) month moratorium by the Village of Rouses Point on the acceptance and approval of building permit applications for the use, installation and placement of electric boilers and hot air furnaces within the Village of Rouses Point.

SECTION 2:

The Village of Rouses Point is currently undertaking a review and update of its municipal electric system.

A review of the municipal electric system of the Village of Rouses Point demonstrates that certain uses of electricity are not just inefficient, but pose an unreasonable and undesirable burden upon the electric system of the Village. Concerns exist over the proper and appropriate use of electric boilers and hot air furnaces within the Village of Rouses Point.

Regulations controlling the use of electric boilers and hot air furnaces are designed to improve efficiency and quality of life in the Village's neighborhoods and business areas and to reduce costs to all customers, reduce capital needs and improve reliability, voltage and service of the municipal electric system of the Village of Rouses Point for its residents.

SECTION 3:

The Village Board of the Village of Rouses Point intends on commencing a study and review of the Village's municipal electric system including specifically regulations for the use of electric boiler and hot air furnace within the Village.

SECTION 4:

A reasonable time for the Village Board to complete their aforementioned study and review, and for the Village Board to enact any required legislation or regulations resulting therefrom, is eighteen (18) months from the date of the Local Law enacting the moratorium is filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.

SECTION 5:

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, work, or part or provision of the Local law, or the application thereof, be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction as invalid, such adjudication shall not affect or impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined to its operation to the article, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, work or part or provisions thereof directly involved in the controversy in which judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 6:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.






