

Section 1. Legislative Intent:

۰. -

1.1 It is the intent of this Local Law to amend Chapter 12 of the Village Code of the Village of Rouses Point "Vehicles and Traffic" and specifically Article VII "Schedules", Subsection 112-37 Schedule IV: "Stop Intersections" to add the intersection of Pine Street and Maple Street as a four (4) way stop intersection.

Section 2. Purpose:

2.1. Wherefore, after thoroughly reviewing the traffic flow and traffic patterns in the area of Pine Street and Maple Street in the Village of Rouses Point and the impact on the safety of the residents of the Village of Rouses Point, the Village Board of the Village of Rouses Point has resolved that the intersection of Pine Street and Maple Street in the Village of Rouses Point become a four (4) way stop intersection and that the Village Code be amended accordingly.

Section 3. <u>Authority:</u>

3.1. Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York and Sections 6-602 and 4-412 of the Village Law of the State of New York empowers the Village Board of the Village of Rouses Point to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Rouses Point.

Section 4. Severability:

4.1. If any clause, sentence or paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall by adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date:

5.1. This local law shall take effect upon the filing with the Secretary of State.
