AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 18 – DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN (DROP), SEC. 18-2, GOVERNING PARTICIPATION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

ORDINANCE NO. 1335

TO ADOPT AND PUBLISH AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 18 – DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN (DROP), SEC. 18-2, GOVERNING PARTICIPATION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City of Roseville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18 – Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP), Sec. 18-2, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

§ 18-2 Participation.

Any member to whom DROP eligibility has been granted may participate in the DROP on a year-to-year basis, subject to annual review and approval, for an aggregate period of no more than ten (10) years. There is no minimum time period for participation. For years 8 through 10, one year extensions only may be granted regardless of any provision within a collective bargaining agreement or personal services contract. An employee must cease service from their current position with the City of Roseville at the time their DROP participation ceases. In no event shall participation in the DROP require a just-cause standard for termination of the employee in participating in the DROP, notwithstanding any agreement, collective bargaining agreement, personal services contract, Act 78 or any other writing governing the employment relationship between the participant and the City of Roseville. Annual DROP participation is at the sole discretion of the City of Roseville.

- <u>Section 2.</u> The City of Roseville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18 Deferred Retirement Option Plan (DROP), Sec. 18-2(B), is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Severability. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent

jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of remaining portions of the ordinance, being the intent of the City that this ordinance shall be fully severable.

<u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. This amendment to the City of Roseville Code of Ordinances shall become effective within twenty (20) days of adoption.
