§ 470-3 Definitions and word usage.

For the purpose of this chapter certain words, terms and phrases shall be interpreted or defined as follows:

ARTISAN MANUFACTURING

The shared or individual use of handtools, mechanical tools and electronic tools, and which may include instruction in the use of those tools, for the manufacture of finished products or parts including design, processing, fabrication, assembly, treatment, and packaging of products; as well as the incidental storage, sales and distribution of such products. Typical artisan manufacturing uses include, but are not limited to, electronic goods; printmaking; leather products; jewelry and clothing/apparel; metal work; wood work; furniture; glass or ceramic production; paper manufacturing. Artisan manufacturing uses shall include a retail sales component that is publicly accessible.

EDUCATIONAL OR QUASI-EDUCATIONAL ESTABLISHMENT

A facility used for education or instruction such as, but not limited to, ballet or dance schools, martial arts schools, nursery schools, tutoring centers, yoga studios, and business, vocational or technical schools.

FOOD AND DRINK ESTABLISHMENT

An establishment which serves food and drink primarily for consumption off the premises and may have limited seating for patrons. Examples include, but are not limited to, delicatessens, ice cream and frozen yogurt shops, and retail stores which prepare, store or sell food or drinks, such as convenience stores.

GALLERY

A space for the display or sale of works of art.

INTERIOR DESIGN SHOWROOM

A space used to display products for sale related to interior design furnishings, such as furniture, carpets or window treatments.

MEDICAL OFFICE

The office or studio of a physician, dentist, optometrist, optician, chiropractor, physical therapist and similar licensed professionals, or a group of such professionals.

OUTDOOR CAFE

An outdoor designated area that is located on the property of a restaurant or retail store or on the public sidewalk or the right-of-way immediately adjacent to the property of an existing restaurant or retail store and where food and beverages that are normally offered to the public inside the restaurant or retail store are offered and served to the public in the designated outdoor area.

PERSONAL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT

An establishment primarily engaged in providing services involving the care of a person or his or her personal goods or apparel. Examples include, but are not limited to, barbershops, beauty parlors, nail salons, dry cleaning pickup establishments, laundries, copy establishments, tailors, household and electronic repair establishments, health clubs, gyms, and travel agencies.

PET GROOMING FACILITY

An establishment designed or used for grooming dogs, cats or other household domestic animals, and may offer ancillary retail sales of pet care supplies and food. Such facility shall not include pet training, daycare or overnight boarding.

PROFESSIONAL OFFICE

The office or studio of a lawyer, professional engineer, land surveyor, planner, registered architect, accountant and similar licensed professionals, or a group of such professionals.

RESTAURANT

An establishment which serves food and drink primarily or exclusively for consumption on the premises and has seating for patrons.

RETAIL STORE

An establishment engaged in the selling or rental of merchandise (usually to the general public for personal use or household consumption, although they may also serve business and institutional clients) and in rendering services incidental to the sale of such goods.

SELF-STORAGE FACILITY

Shall mean a building containing separate, individual and private storage spaces available for lease or rent for varying periods of time.


