ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTERS 166 AND A275 OF THE ROCKWOOD CITY CODE TO: (1) AMEND THE HEADING OF CHAPTER 166; (2) TO AMEND SECTION §166-7(A) TO REQUIRE A PEDDLER'S LICENSE FOR SALES BY FARMERS AND TRUCK GARDENERS; (3) TO AMEND THE LICENSE FEES FOR PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS IN CHAPTER A275, SECTION A275-1; AND (4) TO DELETE ARTICLE III, SECTIONS 166-17 THROUGH SECTION 166-22 CONCERNING TRANSIENT MERCHANTS.

Section 1. That the Chapter heading for Chapter 166 of the Rockwood City Code is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Chapter 166. PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS"

Section 2. That Chapter 166, Article I Peddlers, Section 166-7(A) of the Rockwood City Code is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Sec. 166-7. Exceptions.

A. Any person under 18 years of age when engaged in peddling on foot in the neighborhood of his or her residence under the direct supervision of any school or recognized charitable or religious organization shall be exempt from the licensing requirements of this article but shall be subject to the other provisions hereof."

Section 3. That Chapter 166, Article III Transient Merchants, Sections 166-17 through Section 166-22, inclusive, of the Rockwood City Code are hereby deleted and repealed.

Section 4. That Chapter A275 Licenses, Section A275-1 of the Rockwood City Code is hereby amended to provide that the fee for a Peddlers License shall be \$200 per day, the fee for a Solicitors License shall be \$100 per day, and the reference in this section to Transient Merchants shall be deleted.

Section 5. **Saving Clause.** Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 6. **Severability.** Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction or by any state agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holdings shall be construed and limited to such work, sentence,

phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be so invalid shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Rockwood inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.


This ordinance has been approved by the City of Rockwood City Council in a regular meeting held on November 2, 2016, at City Hall at a properly noticed meeting.
