## ORDINANCE NO. <u>2521</u> ROSS TOWNSHIP ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROSS, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATION A PORTION OF A PAPER STREET ADJACENT TO 113 WILLIAM STREET IN ROSS TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Ross Township received a request to vacate a portion of a paper street n unnamed alley located in the Township of Ross, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 53 P.S. § 57005, the Board of Commissioners deems it to be necessary for the public convenience and for the general benefit and welfare of the public to vacate a portion of an unnamed paper street as described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have determined that no private property owners are harmed or damaged by such vacation of the road and the portion of the paper street to be vacated is useless, inconvenient, and/or burdensome; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has met the procedural requirements of the First-Class Township Code for the adoption of this proposed Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Ross Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**Section 1.** That the portion of the paper street, adjacent to 113 William Street, as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto is hereby vacated and abandoned for public use according to laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**Section 2.** The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the appropriate Township officials and employees to take any and all action to effectuate the vacation of the portion of the unnamed alley as set forth in Exhibit A.

**Section 3**. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provisions shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4**. The failure of Ross Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.




