ORDINANCE NO. 929

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROYERSFORD,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE
BOROUGH CODE, CHAPTER 450, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
PROHIBITING THE USE OF A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE FOR
LIVING PURPOSES, PARKING OF UNHITCHED VEHICLES IN
BOROUGH PARKING LOTS, AND TRACTOR TRAILER PARKING
ON CHESTNUT STREET BETWEEN LEWIS ROAD AND NORTH 7TH
AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Royersford has established regulations through ordinances governing vehicles within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Royersford, desires to adopt certain regulations regarding the use of recreational vehicles and the parking of unhitched vehicles, within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Royersford, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 450 Vehicles and Traffic, Section 41, Parking of trailers and truck camper bodies prohibited of the Code of the Borough of Royersford, shall be repealed and replaced as follows:

§450-41. Parking of trailers and truck camper bodies, and occupancy of recreational vehicles prohibited.

A. Definitions. For purposes of this section, the following phrases and words shall have the meanings indicated:

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE - A vehicle used customarily for human habitation or recreational activities during tours or vacation periods including, but not limited to, travel homes, travel trailers, motor homes, truck campers, trailers, boats and trailers, snowmobiles and trailers, and any other similar vehicles.

B. Parking of trailers and truck camper bodies prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park on any street or alley within the Borough of Royersford, or in any Borough parking lot, a recreational vehicle, a trailer, recreational trailer, house trailer, boat trailer, or other similar vehicle as said terms are defined in the Vehicle Code, Title 75 Pa. C.S.A. as amended, or any truck camper body when any of the foregoing are not attached to or mounted on a motor vehicle as said term is defined in the Vehicle Code, Title 75 Pa. C.S.A., as amended.

C. Recreational vehicle occupancy prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any recreational vehicle to be occupied for living purposes within the Borough of Royersford, whether located on a public street, public property, or private property.

Section 3. Chapter 450 Vehicles and Traffic, Section 37, Parking of trucks, buses and certain other vehicles, of the Code of the Borough of Royersford, shall be amended as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, or to allow to remain parked, on any of the following streets or parts of streets, any vehicle other than a passenger car (which shall not include any bus, motor home, tractor trailer or passenger car attached to a trailer of any kind):

Street or Bridge	Between
Chestnut Street	Lewis Road and North 7 th Avenue

Section 4. Severability. The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

Section 5. Repealer. The remaining provisions of the Borough Code in force immediately before the enactment of this Ordinance are intended to be continued and, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, are hereby re-enacted and re-ordained; and provisions inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as referenced.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective in accordance with applicable law.
