Ordinance No. 417

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSSLYN FARMS, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 183, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, SECTIONS 183-24 AND 183-27, TO ESTABLISH A NEW ONE WAY STREET AND NEW STOP SIGNS INTERSECTIONS, RESPECTIVELY, FOR CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH, AND IMPOSE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

WHEREAS, Chapter 61 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S. §§ 6101, *et seq.*, grants authority to local municipalities to ordain reasonable rules and regulations for the control of the movement of motor vehicle traffic; and

WHEREAS, Section 3308(a) of the Vehicle Code authorizes local authorities, with respect to highways under their jurisdictions, to designate any highway, roadway, part of a roadway or specific lanes upon which vehicular traffic shall proceed in one direction at all times; and

WHEREAS, Section 6124 of the Vehicle Code authorizes local authorities on intersections of highways under their jurisdiction to erect and maintain stop signs and to designate intersections at which vehicular traffic on one or more of the roadways should stop before entering the intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has conducted a stop sign warrant analysis and report for the intersections of Terrace Road / Pilgrim Road / Park Road, Kings Highway / Rosslyn Road / Club Road, and Rosslyn Road / Alden Road / Parkway Ramp, and has recommended that the aforementioned intersections be converted to an All-Way stop controlled intersection, and that Kings Highway at its intersection with Club Road be established as one-way; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Rosslyn Farms has determined that the health, safety and welfare of residents, motorists, and pedestrians requires that the traffic restrictions described below be established.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Rosslyn Farms, County of Allegheny and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 61, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Traffic Regulations, Section 183-24 of the Rosslyn Farms Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following new street as a one-way street, as described:

Street	From	To	Direction of Travel
Kings Highway	Kings Highway	Club Road	Northeast

Section 2. Chapter 61, Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Traffic Regulations, Section 183-27 of the Rosslyn Farms Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following new intersections as stop intersections, as described:

Stop Street	Intersection or Through Street	Direction of Travel
Kings Highway	Int. of Kings Highway w/Club Road and Rosslyn Road	Northwest
Kings Highway	Int. of Kings Highway w/Club Road and Rosslyn Road	Southeast
Pilgrim Road	Int. of Pilgrim Road w/Terrace Road and Park Road	Northeast
Rosslyn Road	Int. of Rosslyn Road w/Alden Road and Parkway West Off-Ramp	South

Section 3. A. Pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S. §§ 6109(a) and (b), the proper officers of the Borough of Rosslyn Farms are hereby authorized and directed to have signs erected and to take other measures as may be appropriate in order to implement and enforce all regulations and restrictions set forth in this Ordinance.

B. The above-described regulations and restrictions shall be in effect as of the date upon which appropriate signs or other forms of notice of such regulations or restrictions are erected or implemented.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs.

Section 5. Should any part or portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intention of the Borough Council that all remaining parts or portions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect to the full extent permitted by law.

Section 6. Any ordinance or resolution inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and approval by the Mayor.
