§ 223-31. Acceptance of Privately Constructed Highways as Public Highways.

E. Private highways with utilities which are not City owned utilities, nor intended to become City owned utilities, will not be accepted by the City as a public highway. Such utilities are but not limited to, water, sewer or drainage that are located beneath, alongside or otherwise in the right of way. Exceptions may be made for underground or aerial electrical and communications installed and maintained by entities licensed by their trade, which do not interfere with the construction or maintenance of pavement, sidewalks, drainage or other right of way infrastructure.
