

AN ORDINANCE ADDING 355.095 SEMI-TRAILER TRUCK PARKING TO THE CITY OF ROGERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

February 06, 2023,

WHEREAS, the City of Rogersville, Missouri is a municipal corporation of the fourth class, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen agree that the addition of 355.095 SEMI-TRAILER TRUCK PARKING TO THE CITY OF ROGERSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ROGERSVILLE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 355.095 Semi-Trailer Truck Parking.


- A. No person shall park a semi-trailer truck, or any portion thereof including the detached semi-trailer, on any public street or right-of-way as follows:
 - 1. At any time in a residential zoning district; except when repairs shall be necessitated by an emergency. This Section shall not apply when actively loading or unloading a semi-trailer.
- B. Semi-trucks may park at any time in commercial and industrial areas so long as traffic is not impeded unless otherwise restricted.

PASSED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Rogersville this January 19, 2023, after its second reading.

APPROVED by the Mayor of the City of Rogersville this January 19, 2023.
