AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 705.040 DEPOSIT

WHEREAS, the City of Rogersville, Missouri is a municipal corporation of the fourth class, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, after the Board of Alderman reviewed it has been determined that Amending Section 705.040 deposits,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen agree that the listed municipal code changes will reduce the City of Rogersville's outstanding accounts receivable,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ROGERSVILLE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 705.040 Deposit.

- 1. Residentially zoned property users shall pay to the City Clerk or their designee one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00). This fee shall be called a utility deposit. The utility deposit shall be refunded to the user subject to the exceptions contained herein upon voluntary disconnection.
- 2. Non-residentially zoned property users shall pay to the City Clerk or their designee two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). If services accounts become delinquent for non-payment, the deposit amount will be increased one hundred dollars (\$100.00) each time the service account becomes delinquent. The additional deposit amount shall be due with the account delinquent fee and outstanding charges prior to reconnection of services The utility deposit shall be refunded to the user subject to the exceptions contained herein upon voluntary disconnection.
- 3. Apartment (as defined in Section 405.080) users where one (1) meter provides services to a dwelling group (as defined in Section 405.080) shall pay to the City Clerk or their designee two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). If service accounts become delinquent for non-payment, the deposit amount will be increased one hundred dollars (\$100.00) each time the service account becomes delinquent Any additional deposit amount shall be due with the account delinquent fee and outstanding charges prior to reconnection of services. The utility deposit shall be refunded to the user subject to the exceptions contained herein upon voluntary disconnection.
