## ORDINANCE NO. 10-2024

## BOROUGH OF ROSELAND COUNTY OF ESSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BOND ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$672,000, INCLUDING \$641,250 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSE AND \$30,750 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH ROSELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ROSELAND, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$641,250 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to Section 3(a) of Bond Ordinance #28-2021 of the Borough of Roseland, in the County of Essex, New Jersey (the "Borough"), finally adopted November 23, 2021 (the "Original Bond Ordinance"), is no longer necessary for the purpose of the acquisition of a fire engine for the Roseland Volunteer Department, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto (the "Original Project"), for which the obligations previously were authorized. A portion of the down payment on the Original Project appropriated by the Original Bond Ordinance in the amount \$30,750 from the Capital Improvement Fund is also no longer necessary for the Original Project.

Section 2. The \$672,000, consisting of the \$641,250 proceeds described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 and the \$30,750 from the Capital Improvement Fund, are hereby reappropriated to provide for the following purposes:

c) The acquisition of a door entry lock system, including a panic system equipment and video surveillance equipment for the Municipal			
Building at 19 Harrison Avenue and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.	\$50,000		
3) <u>Vehicles</u> The acquisition of a salter body and dump			
body, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.	\$ <u>100,000</u>

Section 3. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any

inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
