ORDINANCE NO. 04-23

CAPITAL ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT, AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES AND A NEW LADDER FIRE ENGINE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF ROXBURY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$4,432,955 FROM VARIOUS GRANTS, AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS, OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND, THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND THE RESERVE FOR FIRE EQUIPMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP TO PAY THE COST THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby authorized to make various public improvements and to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, new information technology equipment, new communication and security system equipment, and new automotive vehicles, an a new ladder fire engine, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for said Township, as more particularly described in Section 4 hereof. The cost of the improvements includes all work, materials, and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purposes"), the respective amounts of money hereinafter stated as the appropriation for said respective purposes. Said appropriation shall be met from various grants, American Rescue Plan Act funds, Open Space Trust Fund Monies, Reserve for Fire Equipment and the Capital Improvement

Fund moneys appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Township.

Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the State Grant hereinafter appropriated, and (3) the amount of each sum which is provided by the County grant hereinafter appropriated, and (4) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the American Rescue Plan Act funds hereinafter appropriated, and (5) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the Open Space Trust Fund moneys hereinafter appropriated, and (6) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the Reserve for Fire Equipment hereinafter appropriated, and (7) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the appropriation from the Capital Improvement Fund hereinafter made, and (8) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life:

Section 5. The sum of \$250,000 received or to be received as a grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the resurfacing of Emmans Road authorized in Section 4.B hereof.

Section 6. The sum of \$42,000 received or to be received as a grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs is hereby appropriated to the payment cost of the NFPA Turnout gear in Section 4.D hereof.

Section 7. The sum of \$125,000 received or to be received from Morris County as a CDBG Grant is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the Township-wide ADA Ramps in Section 4.B hereof.

Section 8. The sum of \$185,000 is hereby appropriated from the Roxbury Township Open Space Trust Fund to the payment of the cost of Dell Ave Playground improvements in section 4.H hereof.

Section 9. The sum of \$1,180,190 received or to be received as Federal funding through the American Rescue Plan Act, is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the acquisition of the ladder fire engine including original apparatus and equipment, authorized in section 4.E hereof.

Section 10. The sum of \$600,000 is hereby appropriated from the Roxbury Township Reserve for Fire Equipment to the payment of the cost of the acquisition of the fire engine ladder authorized in Section 4.E hereof.

Section 11. The sum of \$2,050,765 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund to the payment of the cost of

said purposes.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk

and is available for public inspection.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect at the

time and in the manner provided by law.
