ORDINANCE NO. 06-23

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ROXBURY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS, AND THE ACQUISITION OF A NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN AND BY AND FOR THE SEWER UTILITY OF THE TOWNSHIP, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$402,000 FROM THE SEWER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Roxbury, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby authorized to make the following sanitary sewer system improvements, and, to acquire a new automotive vehicle, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for the Sewer Utility of the Township as follows:

(a) Sewer System Improvements

grinder pump replacements

Ajax Mechanical Repairs

Sewer Main Inflow/Infiltration work

Manhole Replacement.

(b) Automobile Vehicles

Utility Truck

Said improvements shall include all work, materials, and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$402,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements and acquisitions

authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Sewer Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Township. The sum of \$402,000 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
